

INFORMATION FOR ATTENDING SUNDAY WORSHIP:

We are preparing for you and your families to be in worship with us for this special day. As you prepare for Sunday, here are the guidelines we will follow, along with a few other suggestions:

- All worship participants, including the ministers, will wear face masks at all times. (If you do not have one, a face mask will be available at the door).
- The doors will open at 10:30 a.m. Please allow enough time to have your temperature checked and find your seat by 10:50 a.m.
- Enter the sanctuary from the Branyon Foyer entrance. (All other doors will remain locked).
- Someone will take your temperature upon entry. (If your temperature is above 100 degrees, you will not be able to attend).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance.
- Go from the entrance directly to the sanctuary and take your assigned seat. Your last name will be on a sign on one of the pews. Please sit on the pew where the sign is placed. This allows for proper spacing in the room for health safety. (Ushers will be in the sanctuary to assist you in finding your seat.)
- We will have printed bulletins at each pew, with scriptures and texts included in the bulletin.
- We will NOT be singing hymns in order to mitigate the risk of airborne transmission. (Humming behind your mask is permitted.)
- Offering plates will not be passed during the service. Contributions and offerings may be placed in offering plates as you exit the sanctuary after the service.
- When speaking with others in attendance, remember to maintain appropriate spacing.
- At the conclusion of the service, ushers will dismiss everyone by row during the postlude. Please exit the building through the Branyon Foyer to the parking lot without stopping.
- Restrooms located on the hall between the sanctuary and Fellowship Hall, as well as the restroom immediately off the Branyon Foyer will be available. We request that there be only one person in the restroom at a time.
- Please Note: If you test positive within two weeks after your attendance in worship, please contact the church office.
