

**INFORMATION FOR ATTENDING SUNDAY WORSHIP:**

We are preparing for you and your families to be in worship with us for this special day. As you prepare for Sunday, here are the guidelines we are following at present, along with a few other suggestions.

- All worship participants, including the ministers, wear face masks, covering the mouth and the nose, at all times when in the building. (Masks are available at the door if you do not have one).
- Children are welcome to attend and sit with their parents. However, nursery child care is not provided at this time.
- The doors will be open at 10:30. Please allow enough time to have your temperature checked and find your seat by 10:50.
- Enter the sanctuary, from the Branyon Foyer entrance. (All other doors remain locked).
- Someone will take your temperature upon entry. (Unfortunately, if your temperature is above 100°, you will not be able to attend).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance.
- Go from the entrance directly to the sanctuary and take your seat. Seating is assigned for everyone. Your last name will be on a sign on one of the pews. Please sit on the pew where the sign is placed. This allows for proper spacing in the room for health safety. (Ushers will be there to assist you in finding the seat reserved for you in the sanctuary).
- We will have printed bulletins, with scriptures and texts included in the service.
- The congregation will remain seated during the hymns; singing is permitted.
- Offering plates will not be passed during the service. Contributions and offerings may be placed in offering plates as you exit the sanctuary after the service.
- When speaking with others in attendance, remember to maintain appropriate spacing.
- At the conclusion of the service, ushers will dismiss everyone row by row, during the postlude. Please continue exiting the building through the Branyon Foyer to the parking lot.
- Restroom use: Restrooms located on the hall between the sanctuary and fellowship hall will be available, as well as the restroom immediately off of the Branyon Foyer. Information will be posted requesting that there be only one person in the restroom at a time.
- Please Note: If you test positive within two weeks of your attendance in worship, please contact the church office.
